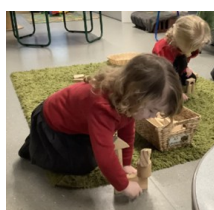


# FOSTON PRIMARY SCHOOL BULLETIN

Stillington, Foston and Langton children will be travelling on buses to Terrington with adults from their school. This event is held during school time and the children will be returned to their school before the end of the school day.

Children in years 1 – 6 are asked to bring a packed lunch or order one from school. **Please can orders be placed for a school packed lunch by Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February**, this is so our school cook can order items in.

Children to come to school in their PE kits and bring a suitable jacket/coat for the weather that day These will be sent home on the Thursday.

Reception and nursery children will also take part in some different sport. If your child comes to school on a Friday and does not have their PE kit in school, please can the come into school in their PE kits.

Hot school lunches will be available for reception and nursery children if they require one, these can be ordered on the day.



As part of our enhancement day the children be taking part in fundraising event for their school, this will involve the children participating in different types of circuit training.
