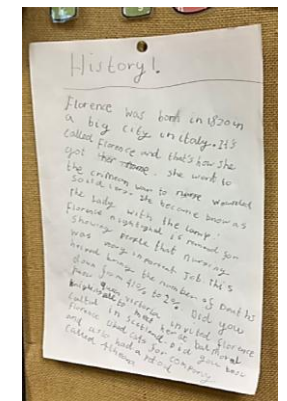
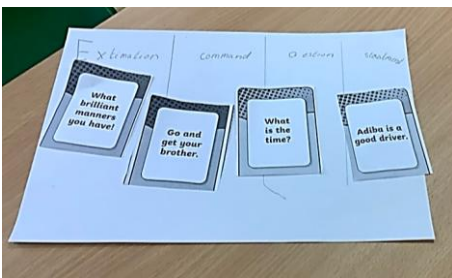
Class 1
