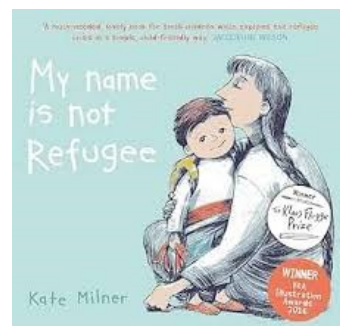
Nursery and Reception

Although this is not in all of our schools, some children do have TikTok and it is always good to share this very useful website called Commonsense Media which will give parents age appropriate suggestions for this and other programmes/films/games, as well as a guide to what parents need to know.

Parents Need to Know

Parents need to know that *Squid Game* is a Korean thriller that features very intense violence and hundreds of bloody deaths. Characters are systematically tortured and killed for the sadistic pleasure of a game master and the delight of wealthy patrons. Players turn against and harm or kill each other to stay alive. Adults have sex, and there are threats of sexual violence: Women are grabbed by the hair and beaten. Themes concerning the highs one gets from gambling, winning, or conning money are a main focus.
