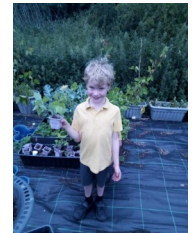


Year 1 & 2

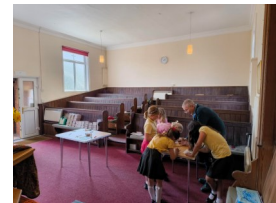
Home Books
