### **Class 1**

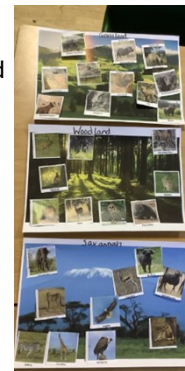

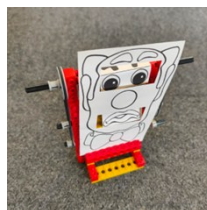
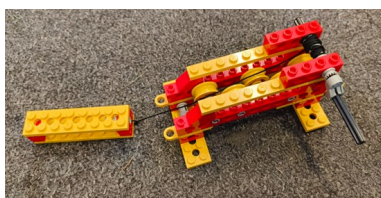
### **Class 3**

### **Malton Sports Centre KS2 event**

On Wednesday 8th of October, the children in KS2 (Years 3, 4, 5, and 6) will be taking part in a football event at Malton Sports Centre. The children are asked to come into school in their uniform and will get changed at school into their PE kits, trainers to be worn (**NO Football boots**). Children will also need to be wearing their school jumpers. They will have lunch at school as normal. A member of staff will accompany the children on a bus, which will take them to Malton in the afternoon. The children should arrive back in time for the end of the school day.

### **Sports Enhancement Day**

On Friday 10<sup>th</sup> October, children from years 1 – 6 will be taking part in our Sports Enhancement Day at Terrington Village Hall. EYFS children from all schools will be taking part in some PE activities at Terrington Primary School. Stillington, Foston and Langton children will be travelling on buses to Terrington with adults from their school. This event is held during school time and the children will be returned to their school before the end of the school day. Children in years 1 – 6 are asked to bring a packed lunch or order one from school.

Children to come to school in their PE kits and bring a suitable jacket/coat for the weather that day These will be sent home on the Thursday. Reception and nursery children will also take part in some different sport. If your child comes to school on a Friday and does not have their PE kit in school, please can the come into school in their PE kits.
